

The University

Bankura University has started its journey only recently, Bankura University Act was, passed in 2013 the Functioning committee was formed in 2014 and the First Statute of the University published in 2016. 
Laboratory

Educational Methodology

Admission procedures:

After succeeding in the 10+2 examination, the candidates will have the option to get admitted in the college (if sits are available). Application for admission are to be submitted in the prescribed form obtained from our college office. Cost of the prospectus and admission form is mentioned in the fees structure.

Application form has to be deposited by hand at the college office. The following documents should be submitted along with the application form.

- 1. Self-Attested copies of Mark Sheet and Certificate of various examination passed.
- 2. A Character Certificate from the head of the institution last attended.
- 3. A declaration from the guardian that his or her ward shall abide by the rules and regulation of the college and he or she will unquestionably accept the verdict of the college authorities in the event of any disciplinary action taken against his or her ward.

Eligibility

For BCA (Hons.):

- i) The candidate must be Indian National.
- ii) Candidates must have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of West Bengal Council / I.S.C. Examination / C.B.S.E. Examination / Any other equivalent Examination each under (10+2) system of studies, as the case may be, with English as one of the combination subjects.
- iii) Passed H. S. (10+2) with any one the following subjects:

 Mathematics / Statistics / Computer Science / Computer Application / Business Economics & Mathematics (BEM) or Candidates passed in (10+2) level with Vocational Engineering & Technology with pass marks in Additional Mathematics.
- iv) Arts / Science / Commerce graduates passing the respective degree examination (not earlier than 5 years) may also apply for being considered against very limited number of seat(s).

For BBA (Hons.):

- i) The candidate must be Indian National.
- ii) Candidates must have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of West Bengal Council / I.S.C. Examination / C.B.S.E. Examination / Any other equivalent Examination each under (10+2) system of studies, as the case may be, with English as one of the combination.
- iii) Students of any stream (Science, Arts, Commerce, and Vocational etc.) are eligible to apply.
- iv) Arts / Science / Commerce graduates passing the respective degree examination (not earlier than 5 years) may also apply for being considered against very limited number of seat(s).

Note: In addition to the above fees students are required to pay Registration Fee, Enrollment Fee, Examination Fee, Centre Fee and any other fee notified by the university which is not mentioned above.













University Registration & Enrollment

After admission procedures, the date and documents required for Registration & Enrollment will be notified in due course.

Examination

From the Academic Session 2018 onwards New CBCS Syllabus and Question Pattern will be followed. Examination will be held in Semester System. Every year, there will be two semester examinations and during the full tenure of three years there will be six semester examinations. Besides the above university examinations there will be internal examinations through class assignments.

Attendance

A degree student must attend at least 75% of the classes held during the entire period of his/her course of study to appear at the University examination as a collegiate student. Attendance of above 60% but below 75% enables a student to be a non-collegiate examinee. Every student in frequent absence or irregularity in attendance may warrant and subsequent dismissal. Attendance less than 60% will make a student dis-Collegiate and less than 75% will make him/her non-collegiate.

Identity Card

An identity card will be issued to each student of ICIS College which will contain an SID No. (Student Identity Number) and other information such as Name, Address, Mobile No., E-mail ID, Blood Group, Course and Session, students are to submit certificate for their blood group.

Dress Code

For maintaining uniformity among the students of the ICIS College the college has introduced its dress code which is compulsory for the students.


